Positive Action Canada Indigenous HIV/AIDS Initiative

- ✓ Indigenous led
- → A member or associate member of the Canadian Aboriginal AIDS network (CAAN), or work collaboratively in partnership with CAAN or a CAAN member organization



CRITERIA

All community grants must:

- · Focus on the HIV cascade of care
- · Contain a carefully articulated budget
- · Be implemented in Canada only
- Contain strong program evaluation and a focus on knowledge transfer
- · Be replicable and possible to scale up

Please note that preference will be given to projects that focus on treatment optimization.

Community Education and Services Grants

- Programs, campaigns, and services focusing on HIV
- ▼ These can include: HIV treatment education programs; HIV awareness campaigns; direct services for people living with HIV/AIDS; advocacy and communications outreach; workshops and conferences; and the core operations of AIDS Service Organizations across the country

Positive Action Canada Innovation Program

Proposals must:

- Pilot a new program serving people living with HIV; or
- Test modifications to an existing PLHIV-focused program (the modifications are designed to achieve enhanced program outcomes and/or to reach additional populations); or
- Apply best practices/key learnings that have already been demonstrated in the programs of other service providers to model a new PLHIV-focused program or to modify an existing PLHIV-focused program (the initiatives are designed to achieve enhanced program outcomes and/or to reach additional populations)

Positive Action Canada Indigenous HIV/AIDS Initiative

 Proposals must improve HIV support and access to care for Indigenous people living in Canada

FUNDING RESTRICTIONS

- Only one application per organization will be accepted
- · Grants will be one-time only
- Individual project maximum of \$25,000

☐ Description of the unmet need to address
☐ Description of the project (objectives, design, clear targeted outcomes & milestones)
☐ Detailed budget and resources needed
☐ Proposed project partners
☐ Sustainability of the project
